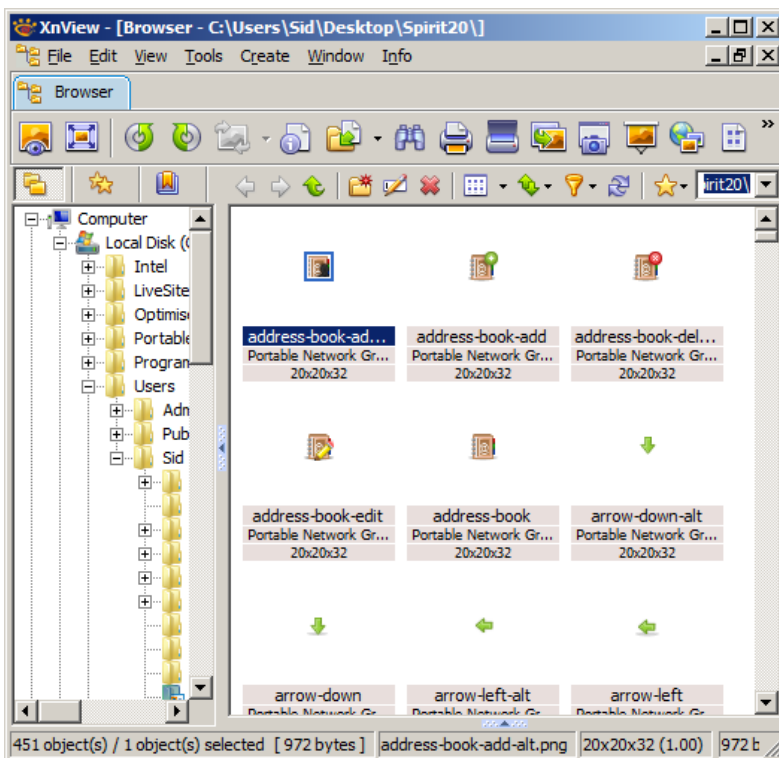
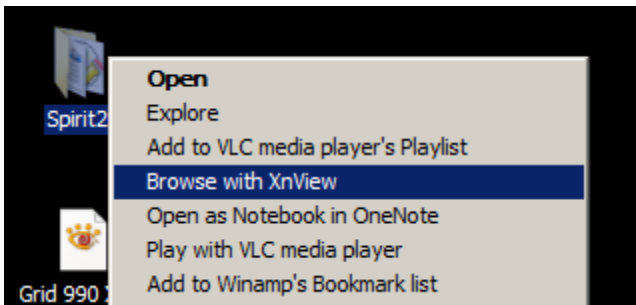
Download XnView from <http://www.xnview.com/en/downloadwin32.html>

XnView v1.97.8 Standard version (JPEG2000)

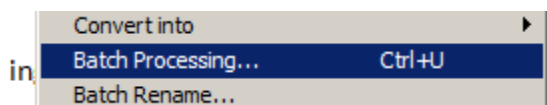
Setup (Multi-language)



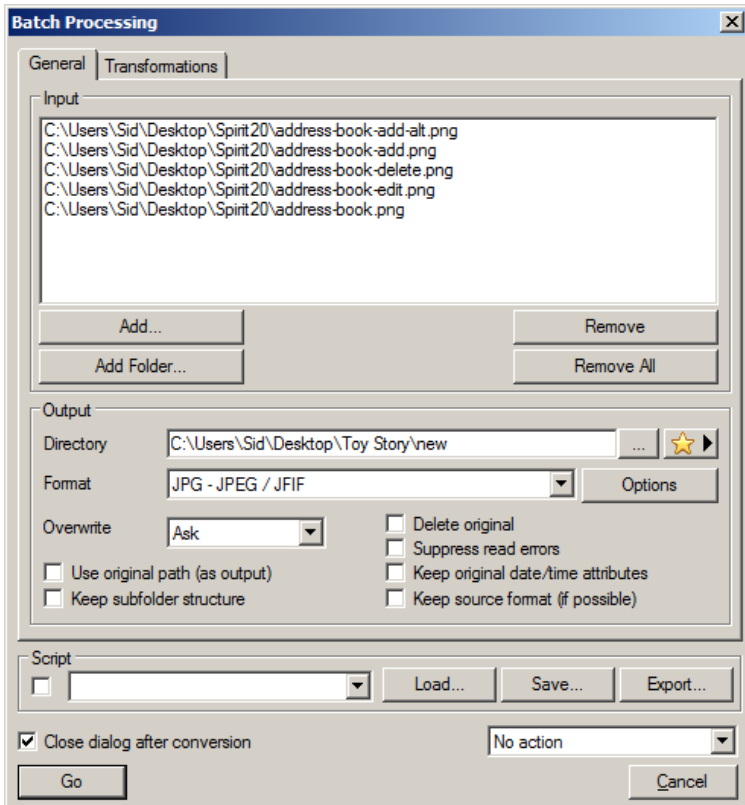
Download and install the application. XnView is one of the best and free image viewing and editing programs.



Select all the images that you wish to resize. Pressing CTRL and clicking will help select multiple images. Once you've selected all the images, right click and you will see this:



Choose **Batch Processing**.

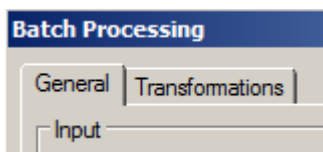


Select the output directory where you want to save all the resized images to. Select the Format to be JPG and click the **options** button next to it.

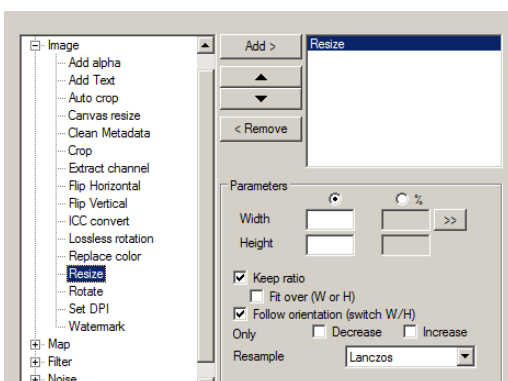


Set the quality to 80. This should be good enough to achieve optimal image file sizes.

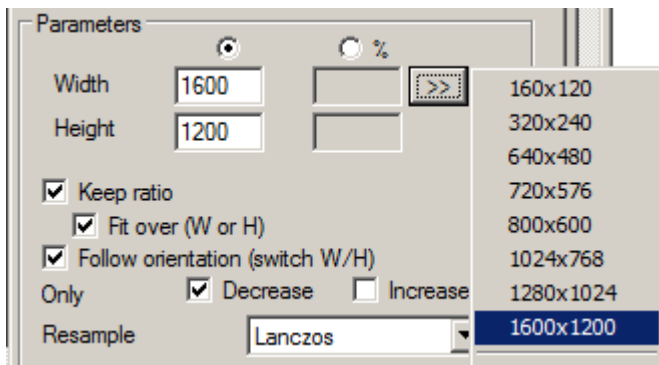
Press OK.



Select **Transformations** from the Batch Processing window.



Double click on **Resize**.



Set the above options.

Press **GO!**

All images will be resized and saved to the directory of your choice.
